Pursuant to the Georgia Rules for Hazardous Site Response, specifically Rule 391-3-19-.05(1) "Listing on the Hazardous Site Inventory," the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) has evaluated the above referenced property to determine whether your property is part of a site where a release of a regulated substance exceeding a reportable quantity has occurred.

Based on the data provided in the June 20, 2007 release notification provided by McDonald's Corporation and Applied Engineering & Construction Services, Inc., EPD has determined your property has been affected by a release exceeding a reportable quantity and will be sublisted as part of the Silverstein's Cleaners site (HSI # 10875) pursuant to Section 391-3-19-.05(1) of the Rules for Hazardous Site Response (available at www.gaepd.org).

The responsible parties will need access to your property to determine the full extent of the contamination that is originating from their property. As long as you cooperate with the responsible parties to allow them access, and provided there are no sources of PCE on your property that are contributing to the observed contamination, EPD will not ask you to complete a compliance status report (CSR) or to complete a clean up at this time.
