- Table of Contents are revised to add a new reference test method and a new quality control procedure for continuous emission monitoring systems.
- Section 2.124 is being amended to modify the reference to retaining monitoring records.
- Appendix A, Method 16C is being added consistent with US EPA.
- Appendix A, Method 201A is being replaced in its entirety consistent with revisions by the US EPA.
- Appendix A, Method 202 is being replaced in its entirety consistent with revisions by the US EPA.
- Appendix B, Performance Specification 6 is being added for Continuous Emission Rate Monitoring Systems consistent with US EPA.
- Appendix B, Performance Specification 11 is being added for Particulate Matter CEMS consistent with US EPA.
- Appendix B, Performance Specification 12A is being amended consistent with revisions by the US EPA.
- Appendix F, Procedure 2 is being added to specify quality assurance procedures for Particulate Matter CEMS consistent with US EPA.
